

## Welcome to Zagreb!

The Zagreb airport is called the Airport "Dr. Franjo Tuđman".

For general research of the flight connections we recommend Skyscanner: <a href="https://www.skyscanner.net">https://www.skyscanner.net</a>

If you don't find any reasonable connection, you may also check the arrival and departure options over the airports in Zadar, Pula, Split, and Ljubljana. Additionally, there are low cost flights to Budapest, from which it takes around five hours by bus or train to Zagreb.

When you arrive at the Airport, you can find a shuttle bus from the Airport to the <u>Central Bus Station</u>, departures are every 30 minutes (from 6 AM till 10:30 PM). The buses are usually white, with the writing "Croatia Airlines" on the side. The Central Bus Station is the last station of the tour, the drive takes around 35 minutes. Taxi is also a good choice. You will find many taxi drivers at the airport. Uber and Bolt are available, too.

Almost everywhere you can pay by card but for a tram ticket you want to buy from the driver you have to prepare coins or you can buy a ticket in the street shop where you can pay with cards. Many people in Croatia speak English and they will be glad to help you if you ask for information. First day of the course we will meet at the main square called <a href="Trg">Trg</a> bana Jelacica.

The course will be located in the centre of the city so we recommend finding accommodation somewhere near the centre of the city.

When you arrive at the Central Bus Station in Drziceva Street and you want to go to the centre of the city, you can take a taxi or Tram no. 6 (towards Crnomerec) and exit at the main square called Trg bana Jelacica or another location near your accommodation. A tram ticket costs about 1 EUR if you buy it in the street shop or about 2 EUR from the driver of the tram.

TISAK is a famous street shop where you can buy tram tickets. ZET is a <u>Zagreb tram company</u>. The pink card is for 30 minutes in all directions. You have to validate the ticket in the yellow machine.
